Presenters: Representatives from the Indiana Department of Natural Resources and other technical resources.

Beginning January 1, 2011, new pump installer licensing and continuing education requirements took effect for water well drillers and water well pump installers. This workshop will cover the new requirements and provide the six hours of continuing education needed for your certification cycle, due for license renewal in 2012.

Presenting will be representatives from the Indiana Department of Natural Resources Division of Water, Indiana Department of Environmental Management, along with other technical resources to be confirmed.

Information presented will include groundwater availability, resource mapping projects, well construction requirements, and regulatory updates regarding well driller and pump installer licensing programs, with an overview of the continuing education for both, and public water supply requirements and permitting processes. Also, other technical topics will be presented.

Upon completion of this workshop, *Water Well Drillers* and *Pump Installers* will *earn 6 continuing education credits* for their license renewal. Additionally, we have applied to IDEM for *water contact hours* for certified *Water Operators*.
